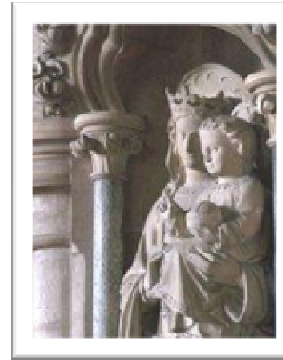


## MARY THE DAWN
