12 Jesus dies on the Cross

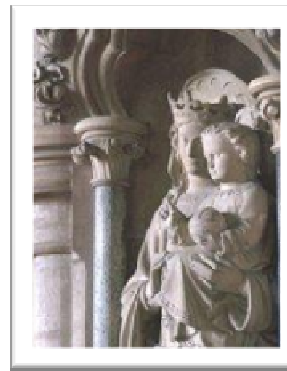
13 The Body of Jesus is taken down from the Cross
