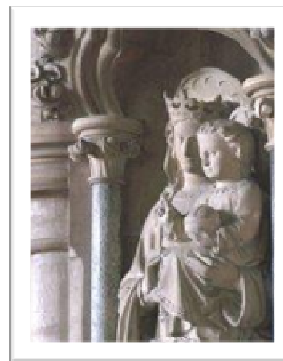


Sacred Heart of Jesus
