

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST ALPHONSUS LIGUORI (1 August)

Born in Naples in 1696, he studied law and took his doctor's degree in both civil and canon law, became a priest, and later founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (the Redemptorists). In order to promote among the faithful a truly Christian life he spent his time in preaching and in writing, especially about moral theology. He was chosen to be Bishop of Sant'Agata dei Goti, but soon gave up the post and returned to his own Congregation. He died at Nocera dei Pagani in Campania in 1787. He wrote many hymns, this well-known one being translated by the Herefordshire-born Redemptorist Edmund Vaughan (1827-1908).
