

OUR LADY OF WALSINGHAM

Among the literature associated with the shrine of Our Lady at Walsingham is a work called the *Pynson Ballad*. It was printed in 1495 by Richard Pynson, though he was probably not its author, and tells the history of the shrine. It is very detailed, and considerably longer than this space will allow. Here then, to whet your appetite, are its first few verses, in lightly modernised language:

OF THIS CHAPEL see here the foundation,
Built in the year of Christ's incarnation
Anno Domini One Thousand and Sixty-One,
In the time of Saint Edward, king of this region.

A noble widow, sometime lady of this town,
Called Richeldis, full virtuous in living,
Desire of Our Lady this petition,
That Richeldis might honour her with some bountiful work.
This Blessed Virgin, Lady most gracious
Granted her petition, as I after shall tell,
Unto her honour to edify this chapel.

In spirit, Our Lady led her to Nazareth,
And showed her the place where Gabriel greeted her:
'Behold, daughter, consider' to her Our Lady said,
'Take carefully the measurements of this space,
And build at Walsingham a copy of this place,
Unto my praise and singular honour;
And all who seek me there shall find succour.

There shall be had in a memorial
The great joy of my salutation
First of my joys, ground and original
Root of mankind's gracious redemption,
When Gabriel to me did relate
That I would be a mother in my virginity,
And conceive God's Son through humility.
