

FEAST OF THE WEEK:

9 November—The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

The Lateran Basilica was built by the Emperor Constantine on the Lateran Hill in Rome in about 324. The feast of its dedication has been celebrated in Rome on 9th November since the twelfth century. In honour of the basilica, the *Mater et Caput*, or 'mother and head of all the churches of the City and the World,' the feast has been extended to the whole Roman Rite as a sign of unity and love towards the See of Peter, which, as St Ignatius of Antioch said in the second century, 'presides over the whole assembly of charity.'

Here is the Collect for the Feast:

O God, who from living and chosen stones prepare an eternal dwelling for your majesty, increase in your Church the spirit of grace you have bestowed, so that by new growth your faithful people may build up the heavenly Jerusalem. Through Christ our Lord.

We pray on this Feast Day for the Holy Father and his intentions:

O God, the Pastor and Ruler of all the faithful, look down, in your mercy, upon your servant, Francis, whom you have appointed to preside over your Church; and grant, we beseech you, that both by word and example, he may edify all those under his charge; so that, with the flock entrusted to him, he may arrive at length unto life everlasting. Through Christ our Lord. Amen

Grant me grace, O merciful God, to desire ardently all that is pleasing to you, to examine it prudently, to acknowledge it truthfully, and to accomplish it perfectly for the praise and glory of your name. Amen.



An act of prayer for the dead, for use throughout November

Out of the depths I have cried unto thee O Lord: Lord, hear my voice. Let your ears be attentive: to the voice of my supplication. If you, O Lord, should observe iniquities : Lord, who shall endure it? For with your there is merciful forgiveness : and by reason of your law I have waited for you, O Lord. My soul has waited on his word : my soul has hoped in the Lord. From the morning watch even unto night : let Israel hope in the Lord. For with the Lord there is mercy : and with him is plentiful redemption. And he shall redeem Israel : from all his iniquities. Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord: and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen. O Lord, hear my prayer : and let my cry come unto you.

Let us pray: O God, the Creator and Redeemer of all the faithful, grant to the souls of your servants departed (N. and N.) the remission of all their sins: that through pious supplications they may obtain the pardon which they have always desired; Who live and reign for ever and ever. Amen.

REMEMBRANCE DAY SUNG

REQUIEMS | This year is the centenary of the Armistice, signed on 11 November 1918. Armistice Day and Remembrance Sunday are this year the same day. That weekend, two Requiem Masses will be offered for the repose of the souls of those who have died in war: **Saturday 10 November**, 5.00pm, Holy Rood. **Sunday 11 November**, 11.15am, Holy Rood, Gabriel Fauré's *Requiem* will be sung.

The **Act of Remembrance** with the two minutes' silence will be held at Holy Rood, beginning at 10.55am (i.e., just before the 11.15am Mass).
